








Total Scholarships Awarded In 2022-2023

PA STATE SYSTEM OF HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

In partnership with the Wolf and Shapiro administrations, Pennsylvania's State System of Higher Education (PASSHE) Foundation launched a new scholarship program for Commonwealth of Pennsylvania employees and their dependents pursuing higher education at a State System university.

Beginning with the Spring 2023 term, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania employees and eligible dependents are eligible for grants of up to \$2,000 per academic year for full-time students and up to \$1,000 for part-time students. Scholarship funds may be used for expenses, including tuition, room, and board.

Workforce Credential Initiative

Credentialing programs are a proven strategy for integrating educational instruction and workforce development. These programs provide a path for low-wage, entry-level workers to more productive employment.

PASSHE's new Grow with Google initiative is an online training program open to PASSHE students and the community to help thousands of people get the skills for some of the most indemand jobs.


Google Career Certificates prepare people with skills for jobs in cybersecurity, data analytics, digital marketing and e-commerce, IT Support, project management and user experience (UX) design. The PASSHE Foundation and Commonwealth University partnered to launch two new workforce initiatives in 2023 for adult learners, supported by scholarships providing up to 90% financial support with a required 10% student match.

Scholarships target adult learners who are lowincome, veterans, or under-represented minorities to earn high-demand, industry recognized credentials through Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) or Commercial Driver's License (CDL) training.

About KEEP

In academic year 2021-22, the PASSHE Foundation piloted the **Keystone Extraordinary Emergency Program** (KEEP) at PennWest University. KEEP assists students experiencing a financial crisis that may disrupt their educational journey by providing immediate, one-time emergency funds.

FUND Help in Hard Times

In 2022-23, the PASSHE Foundation expanded the pilot to include Cheyney University. During the 2022-23 academic year, 117 students received \$85,856 in emergency funding. Awarded students received emergency funds within 48 hours of their application via their preferred cash app.

By keeping students enrolled, KEEP has demonstrated an extraordinary 13.5x ROI per student served on university retained revenues and outstanding outcomes with 87% of students persisting and 89% graduating.

An estimated 3,000,000 students across the U.S. dropped out of college due to financial needs of less than \$1,000. **KEEP** – a critical component of our student success portfolio - helps students stay in college, graduate, and join Pennsylvania's workforce.

The program also aims to address student retention by assisting with referrals to additional services within the campus and local community. 52% of recipients are first generation college students






13.5X ROI per student served on university revenues


FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE Fiscal Year 2022-23


